# Regional Access Center Usage

Results from the 2010 summer survey

AUGUST 25, 2010



## **Summary**

The Regional College Access Center (RCAC) survey was conducted by the Assessment and Research unit of UA Student Affairs in conjunction with the Office of Undergraduate Admissions in the summer of 210. With only 156 complete responses from UA southern Arizona applicants, the survey is of limited use for generalizations of if and how students from the wider community used the Regional College Access Center. Only 13 students who completed the survey indicated that they were aware of the RCAC and thus completed the usage questions. Full results are attached.

Generally, respondents did not know of the center, of those that had heard of RCAC they reported that a school counselor, poster or presentation by RCAC was the source of that information. All of the respondents that new of the center had used the website and not the RCAC office in downtown Tucson.

## **Demographics**

The demographics of the respondents were 61% female, 97% freshmen entering college in the fall of 2010, 88% 17 or 18 year old. Table 1 represents the distribution of high schools from which the respondents graduated and table 2 show the percent of respondents in ethnic categories.

#### Limitations

As described above the number of respondents is low so the data cannot be used to make generalizations. It does demonstrate potential proportions of students who are not aware of or using the center services.

#### Results

The vast majority of respondents **had NOT** heard of the Regional Access Center with 92% indicating **NO** to the following question "Have you heard of the Regional College Access Center?" Thirteen respondents did know of the center so were asked to answer 5 questions about their use of the center.

Only 4 respondents indicated use of the RCAC website while planning for college. Of the 4 respondents who had used the center 3 indicated they had all accessed the following components the Student Tool Kit-scholarship Searches and Financial Aid – FAFSA. Other information accessed included College Planning- Campus Tours and College Transition Checklist and Timeline, NCAA eligibility Guide and the Occupational Outlook Handbook.

None of the 13 students who knew of the center visited the RCAC office or received a scholarship as a result of using the scholarship search.
